REFLECTION

Jesus speaks to a Samaritan woman, and through her, he speaks to us. He describes the kind of worship 'in spirit and in truth'. Indeed, such formal observances are, in the sight of God, of infinitely less consequence than the disposition of heart. This is not to say that formal religious observances are futile or devoid of value-indeed, they are essential to Christians, since they are an expression of our union with Christ's mystical body, the Church.
