REFLECTION

The powerful words of Isaiah, 'If you remove from your midst oppression, false accusation and malicious speech; if you bestow your bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted; then light shall rise for you in the darkness...', are reflected by Paul who in fear and trembling, but relying on the Spirit and the power of God, and as a light in the darkness, preaches Jesus Christ to the Corinthians. Jesus reminds us that we have to let our light shine, so that others, on seeing our good actions, give glory to God.

Outside the walls of the Old City of Jerusalem, is Mount Zion Catholic cemetery. Here on a humble grave is the name, Oskar Schindler. Why is this person, a member of the Nazi Party, buried here? Oskar, though a man with many faults, realised he could not stand by and see the Jewish people sent to the gas chambers without helping them, even at the risk of his own life. He is credited with saving 1,200 Jews during the Holocaust. In 1993, he and his courageous wife, Emilie, were named Righteous Among the Nations by the Israeli government. Oskar, while being aware of his own weaknesses like Paul, let his light shine before others, and helped so may afflicted people. Today, we give thanks to God for such people.

FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SUNDAY 9 FEBRUARY 2020

First Reading

ls 58:7-10

A reading from the prophet Isaiah

Your light will shine like the dawn.

Thus says the Lord: Share your bread with the hungry, and shelter the homeless poor,

clothe the man you see to be naked and turn not from your own kin. Then will your light shine like the dawn and your wound be quickly healed over.

Your integrity will go before you and the glory of the Lord behind you. Cry, and the Lord will answer; call, and he will say, 'I am here.'

If you do away with the yoke, the clenched fist, the wicked word, if you give your bread to the hungry, and relief to the oppressed, your light will rise in the darkness, and your shadows become like noon.

(R.) A light rises in the darkness for the upright.

(R.) Alleluia.

- 1. He is a light in the darkness for the upright: he is generous, merciful and just. The good man takes pity and lends, he conducts his affairs with honour. (R.)
- 2. The just man will never waver:he will be remembered for ever. He has no fear of evil news; with a firm heart he trusts in the Lord. (R.)
- 3. With a steadfast heart he will not fear; open-handed, he gives to the poor; his justice stands firm for ever. His head will be raised in glory. (R.)

Second Reading

1 Cor 2:1-5

A reading from the first letter of St Paul to the Corinthians

I came to you to proclaim Christ crucified.

When I came to you, brothers, it was not with any show of oratory or philosophy, but simply to tell you what God had guaranteed. During my stay with you, the only knowledge I claimed to have was about Jesus, and only about him as the crucified Christ. Far from relying on any power of my own, I came among you in great 'fear and trembling' and in my speeches and the sermons that I gave, there were none of the arguments that belong to philosophy; only a demonstration of the power of the Spirit. And I did this so that your faith should not depend on human philosophy but on the power of God.

Gospel

Mt 5:13-16

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

You are the light of the world.

Jesus said to his disciples: 'You are the salt of the earth. But if salt becomes tasteless, what can make it salty again? It is good for nothing, and can only be thrown out to be trampled underfoot by men.

'You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill-top cannot be hidden. No one lights a lamp to put it under a tub; they put it on the lamp-stand where it shines for everyone in the house. In the same way your light must shine in the sight of men, so that, seeing your good works, they may give the praise to your Father in heaven.'
