Archbishop Anthony Fisher OP has asked for your support in signing an e-petition on this issue to be presented to the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly, since the government's decision amounts to an attack on religious freedom in NSW.

For more than 150 years in NSW, Catholic Metropolitan Cemeteries Trust has been trusted not only by Catholics, but by the Islamic and Jewish communities and other people of faith to bury the dead, maintain their graves respectfully and comfort grieving families.

The NSW Government wants to exclude faith groups from this precious ministry and replace them with a new and costly Government bureaucracy which has no understanding of religious customs around burials, including the importance of leaving graves undisturbed by future generations.

### LATEST COVID-19 UPDATE EFFECTIVE 17 MAY 2021

- 1. Face masks are not compulsory in the church but it is highly recommended.
- 2. Congregational singing is now permitted. Singers or choir members should still remain 1.5 metres away from each other and from members of congregation.
- 3. All attendees are still required to use the QR code for signing in. Those who do not have smart phones must sign in on paper, their name and phone number.
- 4. No booking on all masses. Our church can have 460 attendees observing the 2-square-metre rule. There is no limit on how many can attend weddings, baptisms, funerals but with 2-square metre rule, we can only have 460 people inside the church.
- 5. Avoid congestion before or after mass; attendees should maintain safe distance when lining up for communion.
- Strict hygiene is still required; all are requested to clean the area occupied with the provided paper towels and disinfectants.

### <u>READING MINISTRY</u> (The Role of the Lector)

A Lector or Minister of the Word proclaims the First and Second Readings at Mass. The ministry is open to men, women and young people. Those called to this

ministry use their voice to communicate the Word of God to the Assembly. Speaking skills, of course, can be developed and strengthened with time and experience. The more essential requirement is an appreciation of Scripture as sacred, combined with a desire to bring it alive in people's lives. Readers, therefore, will spend time and effort prior to their rostered date reflecting on the Reading and practising their delivery. There should be nothing in the Reader's manner, dress or demeanour which would detract from their proclamation.

Readers serve on their roster every few weeks at the Mass they nominate. They also undertake the role of Commentator during the period of the roster. Prior to Covid-19, the ministry included over 40 faithful and faith-filled parishioners. We have been blessed to have been able to maintain a roster during this challenging time and look forward to the time when all our Readers, as well as others interested, feel confident to return.
