REFLECTION

I imagine a lot of love and humour in the visit of Mary to Elizabeth. It's likely that the situations of both women would have fuelled gossip in their little villages and among family and friends, and now we meet Mary seeking solidarity and refuge in the home of her cousin Elizabeth. It's helpful to recall the enthusiasm and excitement of their greeting: the child Jesus in Mary's womb 'leaped' for joy and Elizabeth was 'filled with the Holy Spirit'. Perhaps these two didn't meet all that often, but when they did, it was as friends and conversation would have carried on where they had left off at the last visit.

The humour I imagine is in the fact that the man of the house, Zechariah, was silent giving Mary and Elizabeth space to laugh and chat thus making his house their own. All of this during what must have been difficult circumstances for each of them. Their shared humour comes from their confidence that in their unexpected pregnancies, God is at work.

Dear Parishioners and friends,

NSW government and Health had eased restrictions further in NSW from Wednesday, 15 December 2021. There is no limit so we can have full capacity in our church, no restrictions on number of people to attend but we strongly recommend wearing of face masks, though no longer mandatory. We are open with mixed congregations, that is everyone whether fully vaccinated, partially vaccinated or as yet unvaccinated. People who are especially vulnerable, who are vaccinated but anxious about mixing with the unvaccinated, or who are unvaccinated and do not want to risk contact with others, are free to remain at home and join live streamed masses from the cathedral and some parishes. We have to continue to be careful and take all reasonable precautions to protect the health of everyone involved and to observe the directives we have received. We will do all that is reasonably possible to keep everyone safe. We are now back with no limit to church attendees but for our safety, as number of Covid cases are increasing, please still observe social distancing.

We still recommend registration through scanning the Service NSW QR code using smartphones with Service NSW App. For those with no smart mobile phones, please write your name, telephone or email address in the sheet provided upon church entry at main door on weekends, side doors on Weekdays. The wearing of face masks is highly recommended in our church.

Congregation singing is now allowed but please wear mask.

We are trying as much as possible to keep our church a safe place in which all are welcome to come and worship the Lord. Fr Casey and Fr Stephen will be wearing mask during and after mass as required. They know you will understand that they do so for everyone's common protection and compliance.

- Our Lady of Fatima Kingsgrove church reopened for personal prayer from 8:30am to 4:00 pm Tuesday to Saturday from 23 October. Social distancing and hygiene directions apply. No booking required. Entry by side door.
- 2. Daily Mass:

Tuesday- Thursday and Saturday 9:15am
Friday 11:00am-12:00pm Exposition of the Holy
Eucharist followed by Mass at 12:00pm.
No limit of attendees but social distancing and
hygiene directions apply. No booking required.

- 3. Saturday 9:15 am morning Mass is followed by Confession until 10.30am. No booking required.
- Weekend Mass, regular schedule resumed, No limit of attendees. All weekend mass - no Booking required

Saturday Vigil - 5:00pm Sunday - 8:30am 10:00am 5:00pm

- Those unable to attend mass are encouraged to do Prayers at home, read scriptures or watch live streamed mass on TV and asking God for Graces normally received at Holy Communion.
- 6. **Anointing of the sick** will continue to be administered as a Viaticum for the gravely ill and the dying.
- For funerals and baptisms are with no limit of attendees.

- 8. **Weddings** can be celebrated with no limit. Eating and drinking are allowed while standing and singing And dancing are permitted.
- Office OPENED Tuesday, 12 October with the usual opening time 8:30am, closing time 4:00pm with one hour break 12:30 to 1:30pm;
 Christmas break from midday, 24 Dec. to 3 Jan., will re-open 4 Jan. 2022

All of these notices might change depending on the Covid 19 situation.

Parish bulletins will be available online or hard copies may be collected from outside the church on Fridays after 1pm. If you or someone you love is ill and you wish to offer a prayer for them, We are available to pray for you over the telephone. Please call to organise. Please remember that you may offer Mass for anniversaries, special intentions, thanksgiving or any reason simply by placing your request in an envelope and bringing that to the office or in the mass offering box at the presbytery.

Though we have these further easing of restrictions, let us not be complacent as the Delta and Omicron virus are around. Let us shake Heaven with our prayers and care and support one another in faith. Our Lady of Fatima, our celestial Mother, walks with us so let us turn to her in prayer to end this pandemic. We are all one on this journey.
