REFLECTION


Our journey through the Gospel of Luke in our Sunday readings continues to explore human weaknesses. This week's topic encourages us to reflect on the consequences of our life's choices and the values we live by. We meet two symbolic characters, a wealthy man and a poor man, who both face God and are sent to the places they deserve. For Lazarus, this brings relief from the pain and suffering which he experienced on earth. For the rich man it brings the suffering in Hades that he did not expect while living his self-absorbed life. These stories have a common thread, which St Paul highlights in his letter to Timothy, when he encourages him to fight the good fight to win for himself eternal life. While we recognise the weakness of our human nature and how easily we fail, we also see that God accepts us with our shortcomings and his faithful love helps us to refocus, to the see the lonely, hungry and abandoned. Most of the members of our Children's Liturgy, Children's choir, Sacramental Programme educators, Youth Ministry,

Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion, Senior Altar Server, Reader, Warden or counters undertook Safeguarding training in 2019. If you are new to these Ministries and have not attended a parish Safeguarding Induction Training session, please register for an on-line training course at https://

The Safeguarding Office of our Archdiocese has decided that a 3 yearly **Refresher Training** is required for members of these ministries, i.e. those trained in 2019 or earlier.
