REFLECTION

Jesus is speaking about the ordinary things of our loves like eating and drinking, and in faith, we know that in the ordinary moments of our day, He is with us. To help us 'stay awake', and pay attention to what is going on, today's Gospel acclamation expresses trustfully this prayer: "Lord, show us your mercy and love, and grant us your salvation". We gradually learn how much we need God's mercy, love and salvation; praying this prayer gives us light and direction in our daily living. The psalm tells us of the peace which is enduring, calling on us, the 'house of the Lord', living in God's kingdom, our home. We continue to pray: 'Thy kingdom come'. Taking up Isaiah's Advent cue, "O house of Jacob, come let us walk in the light of the Lord", we relate with God and one another in the ordinariness, the sacredness, of each day, enlightened and loved.

"Safeguarding in our Parish

It is my responsibility and your responsibility!

Most of the members of our Children's Liturgy, Children's choir, Sacramental

Programme educators, Youth Ministry, Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion, Senior Altar Server, Reader, Warden or counters undertook Safeguarding training in 2019. If you are new to these Ministries and have not attended a parish Safeguarding Induction Training session, please register for an on-line training course at https://forms.gle/9ebT3voEAtfP7P8R9 or via Zoom by sending an email to safeguardingtraining@sydneycatholic.org

The Safeguarding Office of our Archdiocese has decided that a 3 yearly Refresher Training is required for members of these ministries, i.e. those trained in 2019 or earlier.
