# REFLECTION

Joseph is the main actor in our Gospel today. On learning that Mary is pregnant, he is faced with three choices. He can expose her 'infidelity' and have her put to death under the Law: this one form of righteousness. Or he can send her back quietly to her people before the marriage is completed. This is another, more compassionate form of righteousness. The Gospel today says that he had decided to do this, when the angel appeared and announced the Gospel message to him: the child is of divine origin, and Joseph is to marry Mary, and name him 'Jesus' (God saves). Joseph, like Mary, says 'Yes' to the angel's Word and becomes husband to Mary and Father to her son. This third form of righteousness before God embodies a faith that transcends mere observance, a love and generosity that transcend justice, an acceptance of, and commitment to, a future which gives us our Saviour. Truly a just ('righteous') man! Bring before God all those who have suffered trauma at the hands of church members, the church as a whole, single parents...the list goes on. Mary had her Joseph. May they have her and your compassionate help.

# **OLF PARISH PILGRIM STATUE**



# "Safeguarding in our Parish It is my responsibility and your responsibility!

Most of the members of our Children's Liturgy, Children's choir, Sacramental

Programme educators, Youth Ministry, Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion, Senior Altar Server, Reader, Warden or counters undertook Safeguarding training in 2019. If you are new to these Ministries and have not attended a parish Safeguarding Induction Training session, please register for an on-line training course at https://forms.gle/9ebT3voEAtfP7P8R9 or via Zoom by sending an email to safeguardingtraining@sydneycatholic.org

The Safeguarding Office of our Archdiocese has decided that a 3 yearly Refresher Training is required for members of these ministries, i.e. those trained in 2019 or earlier.
