REFLECTION

This is a very challenging Gospel reading, Jesus upholds the law, but in every case he asks us to go one step further than the letter of the law: we are to fulfil even its spirit. His examples-killing, name-calling, adultery, divorce, swearing-are all just illustrations of the difference between the virtues of 'the scribes and Pharisees' and the virtues that he preaches. Jesus' attitude is what we might call a holistic approach to life. His 'virtue ethics' means that specific choices of actions come from a wider perspective of the heart. It is like seeing through God-tinted glasses. So in our ethical decision-making today, we can be guided by this same attitude. What does 'do not kill' mean in the face of harmful emissions and extinctions of species? What does 'not committing adultery' mean in the face of widespread pornography and human trafficking? What does 'not breaking your oath' mean in the face of fake news and decisions made by artificial intelligence? In all of these, our relationship with God will guide us forward. And, at Mass today, our sign of peace demonstrates how reconciliation with each other enables us to approach the divine. Word Daily Reflections 2023


OLF PARISH PILGRIM STATUE

"Safeguarding in our Parish It is my responsibility and your responsibility!

Most of the members of our Children's Liturgy, Children's choir, Sacramental

Programme educators, Youth Ministry, Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion, Senior Altar Server, Reader, Warden or counters undertook Safeguarding training in 2019. If you are new to these Ministries and have not attended a parish Safeguarding Induction Training session, please register for an on-line training course at https://forms.gle/9ebT3voEAtfP7P8R9 or via Zoom by sending an email to safeguardingtrain-ing@sydneycatholic.org

The Safeguarding Office of our Archdiocese has decided that a 3 yearly **Refresher Training** is required for members of these ministries, i.e. those trained in 2019 or earlier.
