MASS TIMES REFLECTION What is the Transfiguration? What is happening on the Monday: Closed mountain? Why did Jesus take the three disciples with him? Most of the members of our Children's Liturgy, Children's choir, Sacramental

Programme educators, Youth Ministry, Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion, Senior Altar Server, Reader, Warden or counters undertook Safeguarding training in 2019.
