June Topic: Pentecost and the Mystery of Trinity During our Youth Group session, we were fortunate to have Joe and Tuione deliver an inspiring talk on the story of Pentecost and the mystery of the Trinity. They cleverly employed a mandarin as a symbolic representation of the Trinity. In this analogy, the seed of the mandarin represented the Father, signifying His position as the centre of everything. Just as the flesh of the mandarin provides nourishment, the flesh symbolised the Son, God's word made flesh and reminding us of how consuming the body of Christ will give us eternal nourishment. Lastly, the skin of the mandarin symbolised the Holy Spirit, who encompass everything that is good and that we may bear good fruits in his name. Following the talk, we engaged in a question-andanswer session and a summary of the main points discussed. We enjoyed activities, such as a Pentecost-themed trivia game, a race into finding Bible verses related to Pentecost. Additionally, we played a mix-and-match game that involved matching traditional foods with the countries they originated from. This game aimed to highlight

"Safeguarding in our Parish

It is my responsibility and your responsibility! Most of the members of our Children's Liturgy, Children's choir,

Sacramental Programme educators, Youth Ministry, Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion, Senior Altar Server, Reader, Warden or counters undertook Safeguarding training in 2019. If you are new to these Ministries and have not attended a parish Safeguarding Induction Training session, please register for an on-line training course at https:// forms.gle/9ebT3voEAtfP7P8R9 or via Zoom by sending an email to safeguardingtraining@sydneycatholic.org

The Safeguarding Office of our Archdiocese has decided that a 3 yearly Refresher Training is required for members of these ministries, i.e. those trained in 2019 or earlier. Volunteers can register for the new Refresher Training on line via this link https:// forms.gle/XuQFsRsvq3BYtXqT9 or via Zoom by sending an email to safeguardingtraining@sydneycatholic.org Just a reminder that volunteers only need to complete the Refresher Training if they have completed the Induction Training prior to 2020.
