Safeguarding in our Parish It is my responsibility and your responsibility!



Most of the members of our Children's Liturgy, Children's choir, Sacramental Programme educators, Youth Ministry, Acolyte or Minister of Holy Communion, Senior Altar Servers undertook Safeguarding training in 2021. If you are new to these Ministries and have not attended a

And it all began, not at Sydney's congress in 1928, nor Lille's in 1881, nor in the Rocks in 1818, but way back at that first Eucharist in our Gospel today (*Mk* 14:12-26).

Breaking bread He declares to be His body, Jesus tells the disciples to take and receive Him.

The God who assumed our human flesh in the Incarnation and will surrender it in the Passion, now gives us His very substance in the Mass.

Emmanuel (God-with-us) ensures His permanent presence, not just as a notion we might or might not believe or attend to, with fervour or without, but *objectively* present, in the Sacrament at the hands of every priest, in the tabernacle at the heart of every Church, in the mouth and being of every Christian.
